

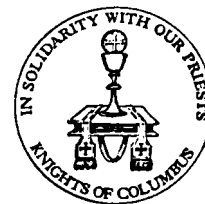

Brother Knights,

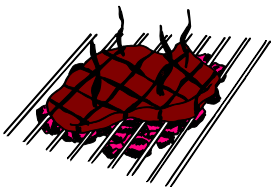

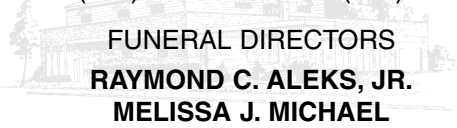
