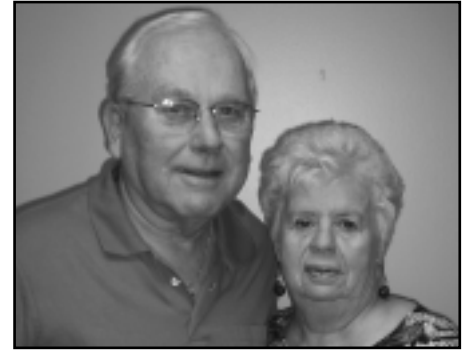
Steve joined our Council in June, 2001. He is single, lives in Taylor and belongs to St. Alfred's parish

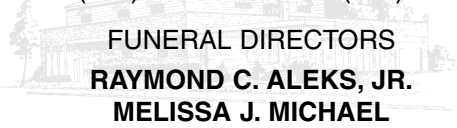
